



### The Lucky Hearts Campaign Memorandum of Understanding

MEDIC agrees to provide TWO 90 minute training courses, to 50 employees (25 in each group, on both the proper steps of Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) and the proper use of an Automated External Defibrillator at **no-cost** to \_\_\_\_\_ (hereby referred to as "the company").

MEDIC will provide refreshments (i.e. lunch) for each training participant, up to 25 people, at each of the 90 minute training courses.

Once both training courses are complete, MEDIC will advise the company on how to design and implement a cardiac emergency protocol for the company's facility.

After successful completion of MEDIC's CPR/AED training course and the emergency protocol has been communicated to all employees, the Mecklenburg Medical Alliance and Endowment (MMAE) will donate an AED to the company, at no-cost.

MEDIC will also advise the company on the best location to mount/store the donated AED.

The company agrees to make available a total of 50 employees for who will actively participate in MEDIC's 90 minute CPR/AED training courses (two groups of 25 employees).

Upon being chosen to participate in the Lucky Hearts Campaign, the company agrees to commit to training dates with MEDIC within 30 days of notification.

The company will provide MEDIC with space large enough to accommodate 25 people (with table and chairs) for each of the two 90 minute training sessions. *(Please note: If your facilities are not large enough to support a training class of 25 people, MEDIC will then host your organization at their training facility)*

After completion of both training sessions, the company will produce a documented emergency protocol for responding to an incident of cardiac arrest at the company, taking into consideration MEDIC's advice on how to devise such a protocol.

Once the company's emergency protocol has been completed and approved by MEDIC personnel, a brand new AED will then be donated to the company by MMAE. The company agrees to immediately mount the new AED in accordance with MEDIC's guidance in a visible, publicly accessible location, and subsequently train all necessary employees on the company's new cardiac arrest protocol.
